- 1. A student will be considered accepted to Kino School only after a 3-day visit has been accomplished and an interview has taken place.
- 2. I (We) understand that a nonrefundable registration fee of \$550 per child must accompany this fully completed form.
- 3. **Tuition obligations are incurred at the time of enrollment during the school year. Payment options may be discussed with the Financial Manager.**
- 4. I (We) understand that registration is complete only when this Registration/Tuition Contract is signed and returned, the Emergency Contact/Immunization form is complete and returned, and, if applicable, student records are received from the previous school. **All scholarship forms must be completed and turned in before or at the time of registration.**
- 5. I (We) understand that tuition payments are due and payable on the first day of the month, unless other arrangements have been made with the office. I (We) understand that if a child attends school for any portion of the month, tuition for the entire month is owed. **When tuition payments become two months in arrears, you son/daughter will not be permitted to attend school until the account is brought current.** In the event of default on this contract, reasonable attorney's fees and costs will be charged should collection action be necessary.
- 6. *\$5,445/semester for High School: Non-refundable. Semester total is due regardless of date of enrollment/withdrawal.
- 7. **Accounts must remain current irrespective of any monies the responsible party expects to receive from a tax organization. Please speak to the finance manager in regards to any outstanding balance.**
- 8. Transcripts and diplomas will be issued only when the account balance is paid in full.
- 9. I (We) understand that each family is asked to contribute an average of **four hours of volunteer work per month**. If that is not feasible, an alternative contribution to the school may be arranged.
